An Announcement of Upcoming Programs for *A Bible Answer*

Due to the movement to unify with the Independent Christian Church in 2006, three programs in January 2007 will address some key areas of thought upon which we differ with them.

Brethren Robert R. Taylor, Gary Colley, and Garland Elkins were selected as our panelists for these programs. We are excited about the tremendous job which each of them did.

The program which will air on January 14, 2007 will be on the theme of "Bible Authority." The program which will air on January 21, 2007 will be on the theme of "The Silence of the Scriptures." Then the program which will air on January 28, 2007 will be on the theme of "Defenses Being made For Instrumental Music In Worship Today."

On October 14, 2006, a discussion took place at Freed-Hardeman University in Henderson, TN entitled, "What Will It Take To Be Together Again?" The participant representing the thinking of the Independent Christian Churches was David Faust, the president of Cincinnati Christian University. Having ordered the DVDs of this discussion, the third program deals mostly with questions which Mr. Faust asked during that discussion.
