The Beauty of Truth

Our nation is observing its quadrennial practice of selecting A president for our United States. To get that job done, the two major parties hold their national conventions, each censuring the other party and making every effort to leave the impression that the faults of the party holding the convention just don't exist. What a strange custom? What kind of thinking could possibly motivate intelligent people to leave the impression that their party makes no mistakes, suffers no scandal, and has the ability to lead our nation faultlessly through the worst of times? What kind of thinking motivates people to leave the impression that the opposite party is possessed of no intelligence, blunders through life without the slightest concept of direction, and has no ability whatever to lead our nation? Of course, most of us have come to accept the fact that this is “just politics,” and the truth of the matter is that most of the rhetoric is just *showmanship*, designed for the purpose of *pumping up* the party, comparable to a pep rally before a ball game. The thought occurred to me as I heard parts of the convention that *truth* is such a beautiful commodity, and it is tragic that we cannot be a truthful people. The Bible, for example, does not build up its good guys, overlook their failures, and leave the impression that some of its characters are all bad while others are all good. Rather, the Bible tells us of David's failures as well as his triumphs. It tells us of the sins of Abraham, of Moses, of Peter, of Paul, while it tells us of their faith, their love, their loyalty. This is reality! This is truth! Jesus commented on the beauty of truth when He said, “let your communication be Yea, yea; Nay, nay: for whatsoever is more than these cometh of evil.” What did He mean? Simply stated, He just meant that a plain, straightforward “Yes” or “No”, coming from an honest heart, has more impact than anything else. There is truly a beauty in truth. Why can't the world see it?
