PSALMS 46:10

January 20, 2010

Are there days when you feel overwhelmed? Do deadlines and time pressures have your mind racing even in your sleep? There is no doubt about it...we live in a stressful environment. Students are given more homework than ever before. Many of our jobs are trying to get us to do the work of two or three people with no extra pay. Between work, the activities of our kids, the activities of retirement, and just daily living we are constantly being pulled in a thousand different directions.

Do you think Jesus ever had days like that? Was it tiring for Him to teach the multitudes, heal them, and feed them? "And He said to them, 'Come aside by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while.' For there were many coming and going, and they did not even have time to eat." Mark 6:31. Jesus knew what it was like to be drained by the constant needs of others. Even in this text the multitudes did not give up. From every city in that area they gathered on the shore to see Jesus when He landed. How did Jesus react? Mark 6:34 tells us that when He saw the multitude He was moved with compassion and began to teach them many things. Not only did He teach them when He was tired, but because they were in a deserted place and had no food...He fed them all with five loaves of bread and two fish. When Jesus needed rest He took time to show compassion on others.

It seems like it is much harder to be patient with others when we are going through so much in our own lives. And it always seems like someone needs something right in the middle of our most hectic moments. How can we be more like Jesus at those times? Remember that Jesus is often seen in quiet places apart from others spending time in prayer with His Father. It would be this connection with God that gave Him the strength He needed in human form to be able to have compassion on others when most of us would have lost our patience. This is the key to our own spiritual strength. It is only by making time to be in the presence of God that we can possibly handle the stresses of life...much less the added stresses that come from trying to help others too. Listen to what we are told in Psalm 46:10, "Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!" Let's take more time to be still and know God.
