James A. Garfield was a Gospel Preacher, Civil War General, Congressman, Senator, and President of the United States. History will never be able to judge what kind of leader he might have been because he was shot by a crazed office seeker and died after only six months in office. However, the following story might be the standard to judge his conduct in that office.

Early one Sunday morning a group of party leaders came by the White House to see him and discuss a bill they thought should be passed by Congress. They were surprised when President Garfield said he had a very important appointment and would talk to them later that afternoon.

"But Mr. President," one man asked, "What could be more important than this?" Garfield arose and walked to the door, turned to look at the party leaders, and said, "Gentlemen, I have an appointment at the Lord's table." He then left with Mrs. Garfield and went to a Sunday morning worship service, not far from the Capital.

Perhaps this should be a lesson for us as Christians that we should never be too busy to attend the local church and worship the Lord as we are commanded to do. What do you have to do any week that is more important than the Lord's Supper and worship?"

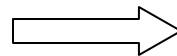
