TSUNAMI CONTRIBUTION

As the people of God, you are to be commended for giving generously last Sunday for Tsunami victims. \$5,172.26 was collected, and the elders added from our general fund to bring the total to \$6,000. Decision was made to use ***Healing Hands International*** to disperse this contribution. They are an international relief organization affiliated with the churches of Christ, and they have a great deal of experience in this kind of effort. (Upon investigation, we learned that 100% of our money will go to disaster victims, with none loss in administrative expenses.) Thank you for sharing so generously.

BIBLE BOWL PRACTICE

The 6-8th grades and the high school will have Bible Bowl practice on Sunday, January 30th at 4:30 p.m. in the fellowship building.

How much good will be accomplished if you participate in our blood drive next Wednesday, February 2? Some days we have only a single day's supply. Because of the wonderful success of our blood drive last June, the Red Cross has challenged us at Northside to have 2 drives this year. The elders were happy to hear this, so our next drive will be on Wednesday, Feb. 2 from 2:30 – 7:30 p.m. All of the congregations in Graves county have been contacted and urged to encourage all or their friends to turn out for this effort. This is a wonderful chance for us to make a real difference in the lives of people.

Moses explained what was so important about blood in Gen. 9:4-6 and in Lev. 17:11 & 14. God said, *Life is in the blood*. Blood sustains life. This should be enough to motivate us to be a blood donor on Wednesday at our multipurpose building. If you have not signed up yet, please call the church office, and we will add your name.

Many of our own church and family members are here because someone like you took time to donate blood. It is amazing to think how many of our own people have received blood connected with an accident or surgery. I can count at least ***thirty-eight*** souls who are presently part of our church family at Northside that have been on the receiving end of blood donations. Factually, for each pint of blood collected, as many as three patients may benefit from their single donation (if their donation is broken down into other usable parts, as is often the case). If our turn out is similar to last year, then we should have between fifty and sixty potential donors sign in. They should produce about forty-six usable pints of blood. If every pint donated were broken down and processed, that means as many as ***one-hundred-thirty-eight people*** could potentially benefit from this drive.

Just think what a difference you can help make if you will share what God has blessed you with. Besides, it may be you, a member of your physical family, or another brother or sister in Christ that will need blood products within the next few weeks. It would be sad for that need to exist, but go unmet due to shortages. A few years ago, I was in the hospital sitting with a family through a serious surgery. Over the intercom came an urgent plea for blood donors. That day one particular blood type was completely depleted in one of our regional hospitals, and lives were at stake.

Have you ever imagined the possibility of your blood donation extending the life of one who would later hear and obey the gospel? You see, we will never know how much potential good we may do by taking time to donate blood on February 2. If you haven't already, please call the office & sign up! I'll look forward to seeing you next Wednesday.
