## The Golden Rule

Have you ever thought about all of the ways Matt. 7:12 applies to our lives? However we want others to treat us is the way we should treat them...in any relationship. If we want respect we must show it first. If we want love, forgiveness, mercy, compassion, or grace from others then we have to treat them that way. Just think about all of the relationships that would change for the better in an instant if we followed the golden rule consistently in our lives.

Another application I want us to focus on in 2008 is in the area of evangelism. If you were lost and knew a Christian, wouldn't you want them to try to reach out to you with the gospel? We are saved. We do not have to face an eternity separated from God, Jesus, heaven, joy, the angels, and all the other saved. What about the golden rule? Doesn't it compel us to do whatever we can to share salvation with anyone we can influence? *“Therefore, whatever you want men to do to you, do also to them...”*

If I was falling and someone could stop me I would want them to...If I was sick and someone could cure me I would want them to...If I was hungry and someone could feed me...Broke and someone could help me...Lost and someone cared enough to show me the way...If you know someone is facing hell then do unto them what you would want them to do for you.

This rule also applies to the Christians who are no longer faithful. If I turn away from God and you know it, please come after me. James 5:19,20 tells us tat a brother can wander from the truth and if someone turns him back they can save his soul from death. What would we want the saved to do for us if we fall away?

One final application concerns the saved. Heb. 10:24 tells us to consider one another in order to stir up love and good works. I need this from you and you need it from me. If I want you to consider me and my needs then I must first consider you and your needs. This is what Paul is telling us in Phil. 2:3,4 when he says for us to esteem each other better than ourselves and look out not only for our own interests, but also for the interests of others. The Golden Rule helps us support and encourage each other to remain faithful as we walk the Christian life together. Think about its power to change relationships and let's apply it to everyone in our lives today.
