When we think of the dynamics of the Christian faith; when we think of the magnitude of the work that God has assigned to His church, we are appalled at the childish immaturity which Christians so often display in their working together for the Lord. The Lord did not give His life in order to establish a kingdom of people who would spend their time “playing church.” He did not die on the cross in order to set up a tightly controlled society of “job assigners” and “job doers.” He gave His precious blood in order to redeem men from sin, and to reconcile them unto a life of service unto God!

Jesus established a church with a WORK TO DO. He ordained in that church evangelists and elders so that the members might be led to such spiritual maturity that they could understand what that work is, and so that they might be motivated and inspired to do that work. It is important that prayers be said, and that songs be directed, and that communion trays be cared for, etc. , etc. , but, when these things have all been done, the real work of the Church still remains to be done!

What are Christians to do? What is it that the Lord wills that Christians do in service as citizens of his Kingdom, or, to put it another way, as members of His church? Christians are to “bear one another’s burdens, and so fulfill the Law of Christ.” (Galatians 6:2) We read, also, “Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such a one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.” (Galatians 6:1) Evangelists are to do this. Both evangelists and elders are to so teach, and to so exemplify such teaching, that all the members will be led to a mature understanding of their Christian duty and will be motivated and inspired to do these things, also. Further, Christians are to carry the gospel message to every creature in every land. Here is a job for everybody! Are you doing your part in the Lord’s work? Are you bringing back the erring, seeking the lost? If you don’t then who will?
