REMEMBER WHEN?

The Bible is full of good principles that a Christian should use in living their life. Time and space would certainly not permit me to make mention of all of them. But there is one that I was reminded of this morning while listening to the radio and that's when things are going awry with your relationships that often times it helps to "remember when".

Now, I know that Paul said in Philippians 3:13 that we are to "*forget those things which are behind and reach forward to those things which are ahead*" but the Bible also says time after time after time that you and I as disciples are to "remember when". As a warning we are told to "remember when" Lot's wife (Luke 17:32). The Lord's Supper at its very core is to "remember when". All throughout God's word people are reminded to remember when this or that happened so as not to forget the lesson learned or the love as it used to be.

In fact one of the most important things you can do when it comes time to salvage a relationship is to "remember when". What happened? What happened to that friendship? What happened to that all consuming feeling of responsibility that you had for that little boy or girl? What happened to your marriage? What happened to your walk with God?
