**I AM A TRACT**

Somebody spent some time and effort in writing me. My author thought that the soul of one individual is worth more than the entire world (cf. Matthew 16:26). The author also believed that the written word is still an effective means of communication.

Because of these beliefs, a considerable amount of time was spent addressing a subject which was intended to lead people to the Lord and His church and/or help them in their service to Him. As the thoughts were put on paper, facts were checked, extensive effort was made to make sure there was proper use of the scriptures, and every effort was made to teach only the truth about the subject addressed.

A printer went to work on me. An effort was made during this phase of my development to make me as attractive as possible and to make sure that the words produced were exactly the words of the author. Unfortunately, I am doing nobody any good right now. I am sitting with all of my friends in a tract rack at the church building. I’ve been here for months. I’m getting tired of seeing the same walls day after day. I cannot begin to tell you how many of the same people walk by me week after week without ever looking my way. Apparently, they are unaware of my potential or of their duty to fulfill the “Great Commission.” (Matthew 28-18-20).

Have you ever thought about the fact that somebody may spend eternity in heaven just because you and I worked together? Wouldn't that be wonderful? Have you ever thought about how great it would be to listen to somebody tell how they became a Christian and realized that a big part of their spiritual journey involved our combined effort?
