**Serial Relationships**

Many of you are old enough to recall the serial "westerns" at the movies – a story would unfold onscreen, week after week, encouraging the audience to return and follow the saga. For those of us who are younger, it might be helpful to know that it was that type of serial that George Lucas tried to emulate when he began the "Star Wars" saga.

According to Webster's New Collegiate Dictionary, a serial is something "appearing in successive parts or numbers." This succession is evident, as in the cases of infamous mass murderers now known as serial killers. There is another type of serial however that I have observed over the years: a serial relationship. It is nothing new – Jesus encountered it when he lived on earth. (See John 4:1-42).

Some serial relations are in the realm of friendship. A person goes out, meets others, and make friends. Time passes, and their part of the friendship is "heavy" on the reliance aspect of friendship – they unburden themselves emotionally, borrow or take things physically, and then, move on to other friends – and the same type of relationships.

Some serial relationships are in the realm of marriage. A person meets someone and marries them (usually with little or no preparation). Time passes – rather than living responsibly and looking after the needs of their mate, they selfishly look for more and more self-fulfillment. Finally, the day comes when they think the marriage has gone far enough, and they move on – usually to another marriage of the same type.

Some serial relationships are in the church. A person searches and searches for "the perfect church." They have their own ideas about what the church should be (namely, providing self-fulfillment and/or enjoyment). Once they find a congregation, they settle in for a while – only to come to a point where they see that the church 1) is not perfect and 2) does not cater to their every whim, and they move on – to find another church.

Have you noticed a pattern? Serial relationships are self-centered relationships – lasting until the person sees no more possibility of self-fulfillment. A Christ-centered relationship on the other hand, looks to fulfill the needs of others (and in so doing, finds his own fulfilled). It is described this way: "*Love...is not selfish...endures all things, love never dies* (1 Corinthians 13:4-8, **McCord**). That's the kind of relationship we need to build.
