HONDURAS SUPPLIES

After Matthew Taylor's presentation on the mission work in Honduras, several of you have asked about helping with supplies and food for this work. The following is a list of items you can purchase and bring to the building. We will see that it is shipped to the church in Florida. However, our time is limited because shipping takes so long, so we need the items by **Sunday, March 27**. If you had rather give money, the director of Torch Missions said they can buy food by the bulk and divide it up into family rations (last year they gave out over 1000 bags of food – 1 bag can feed a family of 8 for 2 weeks!) Another option is to give money for the purchase of Spanish Bibles. These can be purchased for \$1.25 each. If you would like to give money, please see Rickie or Gayna Taylor and note what you would like for your money to be used for. A box has been set up in the front and back foyers for supplies.

Medical supplies: tooth brushes, toothpaste, mouth wash, band-aids, cotton balls, q-tips, antibiotic creams, peroxide, anti-bacterial wipes, latex gloves, aspirin, Tylenol, Advil, cough syrup, cold medicines, children's and adult's vitamins, and powdered baby formula.

Humanitarian supplies: infant and children clothes, cloth diapers, children and adult shoes and socks, hats, belts, blankets, pillows, sheets (twin size), silverware, plates, and cups.

Construction supplies: 20-24 oz hammers, tool belts, tape measures, levels, squares, work gloves, concrete trowels, paint brushes, and rope.

Children's supplies: coloring books, crayons, colored pencils and markers, construction paper, chalk, erasers, toys, stuffed animals, toy jewelry, white typing paper, soccer balls.

Food items: peanut butter, grape jelly, canned meats, hard candy individually wrapped, tubs of Kool-Aid with sugar already in mix.
