Raising Faithful Kids In A Fast Paced World

On April 13th a special class for parents and grandparents will meet in the fellowship hall and meet through May. We will study a book by Dr. Paul Faulkner, *Raising Faithful Kids in a Fast Paced World*. Dr. Faulkner and his wife spent four years in the homes of members of the Lord's church interviewing 30 couples and their children and grandchildren about what it takes to have strong Christian families. Among the leaders of these Christian families were a vice presidents of Ford, DuPont, and IBM; a grocery store owner who does 100 million dollars in sales a year; a national champion football coach; a Texas rancher with an 110,000 acre spread; the largest dairy farmer in Tennessee; physicians; lawyers; an architect; and many others in various lines of work.

Beside the fact that each of these families was successful financially, they were strong families with strong relationships with each other and with God. The research on these families confirms what is found in the Word. The timeless principles found in the Bible are the foundation for every strong family. We are going to study 8 important lessons from these families and make application on how to make our own families stronger. There will be handout material for everyone from each of the chapters we will study, but our class time will only scratch the surface of the material. Actually, we will get to look at less than half of the book. If your family would like a copy of the book, please sign up on the list in the foyer by March 30th. Each book will be \$13. Please be making plans to enjoy this powerful study with us.

- One must **HEAR** the gospel plan of salvation (John 6:45; Revelation 1:3)

- One must **REPENT** of sin (Luke 13:3; Acts 2:38; 3:19)
- One must **CONFESS** Christ deity (Romans 10:9,10; Matthew 10:32,33)
- One must **BE IMMERSSED FOR FORGIVENESS OF SINS** (1 Peter 3:21; Acts 22:16)
- One must **BE FAITHFUL UNTO DEATH** (Revelation 2:10)
