Christian Influence of Parents

One of the most remarkable, and one of the most interesting studies in the Bible is centered around the life of Joseph, the son of Jacob and Rachel. He was sold by his brethren, went into Egypt as a slave, but eventually he became a ruler. When his brethren came to Egypt to buy corn, Joseph devised a plan to get Benjamin, his only full brother, to remain in Egypt with him. As Judah was pleading with Joseph to let Benjamin return to Israel he said these words, "For how shall I go up to my father, and the lad be not with me?" (Gen. 44:34)

This is a soul-searching question, and should serve to make every parent mindful of the words of Paul in Eph. 6:4, "...provoke not your children to wrath; but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord." How can we face our Heavenly Father on the Judgment Day if we fail to lead our children to Christ?

To lead our children to Christ we must be Christians, faithful and zealous in the work of the Lord. We must show our children by our faith and works that Christ is first in our lives. The judgment day is like a harvest, and faithful Christians shall "come rejoicing and bringing in the sheaves."
