“ONE ANOTHER” CHRISTIANITY

Christians must have a deep sense of togetherness, a beautiful bond of relationship and cooperation, if we are truly going to be pleasing to God and help encourage each other to draw closer to heaven (cf. 1 Corinthians 1:10; Romans 14:19; John 13:34-35). Escape and isolation are not the answer: brotherly love and genuine cooperation of every member of the church is the answer.

Ecclesiastes 4:9-12 tells us that in such closeness and sharing there is assistance (vs.9), comfort (vs.11) and defense (vs.12). The point of the section is quite simply, “Two are better than one” (vs.9). We really do need each other! Consider carefully why congregational closeness is so important by examining the principles taught from this passage in Ecclesiastes. Why are two better than one?

Mutual Effort. “Two are better than one, because they have a good reward for their labor” (vs.9). When we work together, more can be accomplished. By working together, tasks that would be impossible for one person to do are made easier through our combined efforts. And work itself is made easier through the encouragement and assistance of others (2 Corinthians 6:1; Philippians 1:27).

- One must **BE FAITHFUL UNTO DEATH** (Revelation 2:10)

Mutual Support. *"For if they fall, one will lift up his companion. But woe to him who is alone when he falls, for he has no one to help him up."* (v.10). The support, encouragement and comfort of others is so necessary to help us keep from falling away from God (Galatians 6:1-2; James 5:19-20). While we have an individual responsibility to grow in Christ, the church must also see the priority of providing the proper type of atmosphere for growth (Ephesians 4:12-16; 1 Corinthians 12:12-28).

Mutual Warmth. *"Again, if two lie down together, they will keep warm; but how can one be warm alone?"* (vs.11). Warmth, concern, and compassion must characterize the Christian community. 1 Peter 1:22 says that we are to "love another fervently with a pure heart."

Mutual Strength. *"Though one may be overpowered by another, two can withstand him"* (v.12). There is mutual defense against Satan and the allurements of sin as Christians walk and work together. There is value in Christians emphasizing togetherness, not only because of fellowship, but due to safety.

If two are better than one, three are even better (Ecclesiastes 4:12). And the doctrinal, functional, and relational unity we are to have in Christ is a cord that cannot easily be broken.
