Sunday morning, she was waiting eagerly as he and his wife pulled up to her house – in fact, she had already called the church building and left a message on the answering machine, pleading that they remember to pick her up. Yes, Linda was there on Sunday morning, and came again Sunday evening. Monday she brought her best friend, **Jasmine**. By Wednesday evening, the concluding service of the meeting, she was proudly announcing to all who would listen that she and Jasmine would be going there on a regular basis!

Studies show that the most effective means of persuading someone to visit a worship service is a *personal invitation*. There may be a "Cathy" in your life, someone just waiting for YOU to invite them. You may be the person they would allow to lead them spiritually. Or, there may be a "Linda," a sweet little child, waiting have her life changed by YOUR act of kindness. Think about it.
