If they do not have a comedian in the pulpit and a ministry of recreation, be loud in your complaints. **Five, demand a Bible that reads like a comic book.** No one should expect young people to study hard to understand God's will for your lives. It is just so frustrating not to have a "Bible" that you can understand. Certainly, that old archaic King James Version and even the American Standard Version are just beyond your ability to grasp.

**Six, do not let anyone tell you how to live your life.** Anyway, how can one really "know the truth" from a Bible so full of contradictions? Oh, have you been told you can trust the Bible? Do not believe it! You guess as to what the Bible teaches is as good as that of anyone else. Besides, have you not heard? It is the age of "do your own thing." Have you not learned by now that certain things are "wrong" only in certain situations?
