2. Be friendly and interact with your brothers and sisters at worship services. The church is a family, and it will be far easier to make your friend feel at home if you can comfortably introduce them to people you know and love.
3. Be knowledgeable of the layout of the church building and related facilities. If you don't know your way around, make sure you know someone you can allow to guide your friend to the places they need to go.
4. Be prepared to accompany your friend most, if not all the time during their visit. It is common courtesy to accompany someone in places and events that are unfamiliar to them. How would you feel if you were the visitor and your friend abandoned you in the same situation (Matthew 7:12)?
5. Be an active participant in the services. Why should a visitor be convinced that singing is a command of God (Ephesians 5:19) if you, a Christian, refuse to sing in a worship service.
6. Be ready to answer any of their questions about the services or the teaching that took place. If you can't do it then delay your answer so you can study your Bible and give an adequate response (1 Peter 3:15).
