### No More Than Love Demands

This past week, I learned that a young man, a freshman at Freed-Hardeman University drowned in the ocean while on a mission trip to the Dominican Republic. Shane Ruiz was wading in the ocean with several friends on the last day of their mission trip, when a rough wave knocked him over and an undertow pulled him out to sea. Attempts were made to rescue him, but all attempts proved futile. This young man was in the Dominican Republic, along with several other fellow students, to teach a Vacation Bible School for the children living there, and work with a Children's Home. After a long week of work, their schedule called for a trip to the ocean before returning home to the United States.

My first thoughts when I heard of this tragedy were the thoughts of a parent. I too, have a child at Freed-Hardeman, and I can only imagine what this young man's parents must be going through. I would ask that you will remember them in your prayers.

But my second thought was the last verse of a song we sometimes sing in our assemblies. The song is entitled, "Follow Me" and was written by Ira Stanpill in 1953. Here is the third verse of that song:

Oh, Jesus if I die upon a foreign field some day,  
T'would be no more than love demands, no less could I repay,  
"No greater love hath mortal man Than for a friend to die",  
These are the words he gently spoke to me.  
"If just a cup of water I place within your hand,  
Then Just a cup of water Is all that I demand",  
But if by death to living they can thy glory see,  
I'll take my cross and follow close to Thee.

Friends, I think all of us, if we could choose, would want to leave this world while doing the work of the Lord. Even Balaam, the wicked, greedy prophet in the Old Testament prayed, "Let me die the death of the righteous, and let my end be like his" (Numbers 23:10).
