**“PRESERVING A GODLY PEOPLE”**

Today, the Lord's church lives in the midst of a culture that for the past fifty years has become increasingly secular that, if left unabated, will challenge our very existence. We work with people who have adopted the philosophies of *relativism* (i.e, nothing is always right or wrong), *pluralism* (i.e, no one should condemn anyone or anything), and *emotionalism* (i.e, feelings are more important than reason or truth). The natural consequence of all this is the philosophy of *individualism*, which expresses itself in attitudes like these: “I am the measure of life; I have a right to be happy. No one can tell me what to do.”

In seeking to save the lost, we find ourselves trying to reach people who have little or no interest in listening to a message of absolute truth with eternal consequences. Their focus is on their own interest and not the Lord's. These false philosophies are also affecting the church.

We are now being encouraged to accept others as being saved regardless of what they have or have not obeyed. Some say we should accommodate our doctrine to include everyone regardless of baptism for the remission of sins or worship with an instrument. They ask, “How can we possibly judge or condemn anyone or any practice when we have such a huge log in our own eye”?

We are in danger of making Israel's tragic mistake, of calling evil good, and good evil (Isaiah 5:20-21). Regardless of our culture, God calls us to be *faithful to Him!*

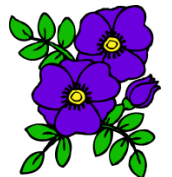
