- What were the Israelites who married foreign women against God's law told to do? Ezra 10:11 says they were told to "separate." Yet people today argue that God nowhere required such separation! But how can this be if the couple has had children? Ezra 10:44 says "some of them had wives by whom that had children," but they were still required to separate.
- What did John the Baptist say about Herod's unscriptural marriage to his brother's actual wife? He did not say, "let me baptize you both and you can stay together." He said, "It is not lawful for thee to have thy brother's wife" (Mark 6:18). Remember, Herod "had married her" (Mark 6:17). When people disobey God, repentance often comes with great pain and sorrow; but heaven is far more important than any earthly joy, and we must be ready to give up anything to have that heavenly home.
