YOUR FUNERAL

I don't know who will preach my funeral, not what he will say, nor what I would want him to say. I won't be in a position to hear it, so my concern would not be a personal one. However, it would be my prayer that even under these circumstances, something might be said that would help someone else to live closer to God and to become more Christ-like. Indeed, what would I want the speaker to say on that occasion? If it were your funeral, and if I were the speaker, what would you want me to say? Would you want me to concentrate on your life as an example of Christianity? Would you want me to place an emphasis upon the faithfulness which characterized your life? Or, contrariwise, would you prefer that I not say anything about your faithfulness, or lack of it? Would you want me to use you as an example of someone who truly gave unstintingly of his time and talent to further the cause of Christ? Could I, with your permission, speak of your family life, your study habits, your prayer life, your devotion to the cause of Christ? I think of the time when David spoke at the grave of Abner. David said, "Know ye not that there is a prince and a great man fallen this day in Israel?" Could that be said of you? Humility, of course, would forbid any right thinking man from requesting that such a thing be said at his own grave, but are you the kind of person about whom something like this *could* be said? Visualize, if you will, that time in your life when some doctor says, "You have but a short while to live." Undoubtedly there are preparation which you will want to make, business matters to clear up, things to get done. Now, tell me what you want me to say to those who gather for your funeral service. Has your life given them a message of hope, an example of faithfulness, an illustration of spiritual integrity. Or would I do better simply to say, "He lived and died; no let's get on with the business of burying him"?
