### Expelled: No Intelligence Allowed

Recently I have read several reviews of a new movie. Entertainer Ben Stein has produced and starred in a documentary which deals with the ongoing debate on the subject of intelligent design versus Darwinism. Blain Kelley, Associate Minister for the South Green Street church of Christ in Glasgow, KY has written the following article dealing with this movie.

This past Sunday night a group of us went to see the new movie Expelled. In case you have yet to hear about it, Expelled is a newly released documentary that addresses the evolution vs. intelligent design debate. While that might make it sound a bit boring, it is anything but that. It stars Ben Stein, a former presidential speechwriter who is now known for his amusing cameo appearances in commercials and comedy films, as well as his hit game show on Comedy Central called "Win Ben Stein's Money."

With Expelled, Stein accomplished something that others have tried and regularly failed at – discussing the philosophical, moral, and social consequences of evolution in a way that is both informative and entertaining. To its credit, this movie appeals to all types of people, regardless of one's knowledge of science. It also addresses how Darwinistic thinking leads to a world view that not only lacks God, but also lacks a sense of ethics and purpose in life.

In many ways the movie is a call to action. Sadly, the predominance of evolutionists in a variety of scholarly fields has caused those of opposing views to either shut up or to be shut out. Stein reminds us that the debate on beginnings has yet to be concluded, and those who believe in an ultimate designer deserve to be heard. After all, true science and a free society allow for the exploration of all ideas, even ones that may imply the existence of God.

I encourage everyone to see the film, especially our parents and young people. This debate is not going away anytime soon, and believers in an ultimate creator should not surrender life's greatest debate just because academia disagrees with us. There is a God and He is alive.
