With all the things he had to do he felt that the Lord was asking for far too much of his time.

Are the Lord's demands of daily discipleship (**Luke 9:23**), holy living (**Romans 12:1-2**), and faithful church attendance (**Hebrews 10:25**) asking too much of the Christian's time? Perhaps if we could see how the average person spends his or her time while here on earth, we might be able to see God's demands of us in a better perspective.
