CHILDREN NEED LOVE, FIRST

I read a story the other day that broke my heart. Sometime back, the ABC program 20/20 interviewed a little boy that had never met his father. The boy stated that he would like to meet his father and do things with him. When the interviewer asked him what kind of things, the boy replied, "guy things." The film crew found the little boy's father and showed him the tape. When they asked him what he thought, the father said, "I'm not into parenting."

Forgive me if I'm wrong, but that father is already "into parenting." He committed a morally irresponsible act that resulted in a child. That makes him a parent, though not a good one. The truth of the matter is, it takes more than biological function to be a parent. It takes a sense of responsibility and the realization that a child is fully human with emotional, spiritual, mental and physical needs that can only be met by caring fathers and mothers.

Children are not born with a sense of what they ought to do and how they ought to do it. That is something that must be taught and it must be taught by those that love them, first. As the apostle Paul says, without love all of our good works are lacking in real value. **(1 Corinthians 13:1-3)**. Good works are essential ingredients in every society, but if they lack proper motivation, they may accomplish little. By the same token, you can train a child to do all sorts of things, but without love they become nothing more than trained pets.

Jesus loved children and they responded to Him positively. **(Mark 10:13-16)**. He had no children of His own (regardless of what some claim today), but He showed the kind of love every parent ought to have for their children. "Jesus loves the little children" says one of our children's songs. It would be a good song for that little boy's "father" to hear.

I'm angry at the "father," but I also feel sorry for him. Maybe he didn't come from a loving home. Jesus loves him, too, but he may not know it. ~Gary Knuckles
