We ought to voluntarily use common sense when we open the closet door, or even better, when we buy our clothes. Even in the 21<sup>st</sup> century we will still applaud decency!

Parents...will you kids grow to respect what the church is and what it stands for? A lot of it may depend on how serious you are about "getting dressed for church!" Something to think about!
