Ten Commandments for College Students

I. Remember your long-range goals. Keep yourself convinced that personal sacrifice now will be well repaid later. ("The good things in life we pay for in advance; the evil things later.")

II. Have a regular time and a set place for study, free from all distractions. Use the library often.

III. Establish a daily routine and stick with it. Write a list of things you want to do today and mark them off as achieved. Read **this** list every day for two weeks.

IV. Keep full written notes in every class. Write down as much of your professor's comments as possible. (Teachers delight in making out tests to include their favorite comments made in class.) Re-read daily your own notes you took the day before while waiting for each class session to begin. Re-read all of them before tests.

V. Get adequate rest every night—8 hours if possible. Fight the tendency to sleep late and miss early classes or breakfast.

VI. Keep up with all assignments daily. Do not neglect daily homework or review; there is no way you can learn difficult material by cramming just before a test. Last minute review, however, is very important.

VII. Choose your associates carefully. Do not run around with losers and duds who encourage you to break good study habits and moral codes. Build close friendships with others who know what their goals are. Inspire and encourage each other. (Share this list with them!)

VIII. Don't forget those who are helping you. Someone will be disappointed if you "goof off" or let them down. Remember those who will be hurt if you do not try.

IX. Think and plan ahead. As you leave your room or go to class, think: "Do I have everything I will need until I return?"

X. Let nothing interfere with your spiritual duties. If you do all of the above, you will have time to participate in every wholesome and reasonable Christian privilege provided by the church or student center. Practice Matt. 6:33. God will help you succeed, but you cannot do His will without His help.
