“ABIDING” IN CHRIST

The New Testament word “abide” (*meno*) means to continue doing something or remain at a task or location. The apostle John, in first epistle (1 John) encourages his readers to “abide” in Christ or continue in him (2:5-6, 24; 3:6, 23-24; 4:12,15). The question is, “How does a Christian, on a daily basis, manifest that he is truly ‘abiding’ in Christ?”

1. **...THROUGH HIS DAILY WALK (2:5-6).** The term “walk” in the New Testament is often employed to describe the daily activities / behaviors of a Christian. Hence, the Christian is to “walk”:
 - In the light – 1 John 1:7,
 - In love – Ephesians 5:1,
 - By the Spirit – Galatians 5:16-24
 - Different from the world – Ephesians 4:17-32,
 - In Good Works – Ephesians 2:1-10.
2. **...THROUGH HIS OBEDIENCE (3:23-24).** Obedience is a behavior that is learned (Hebrews 5:8) and a choice that is made (Acts 4:19 + 5:29). However, without an obedient heart and life one cannot enjoy the salvation made possible by God’s grace and Jesus’ atoning sacrifice (Hebrews 5:9; Matthew 7:21-23; Ephesians 2:4-8).
3. **...THROUGH HIS LOVE FOR OTHERS (4:12).** The Christian’s love (*agape*) for others is not an option; it is an obligation (1 John 4:11, 20-21). Too, it is to be patterned after God’s love for mankind – unconditional love – (1 John 4:7-10; Romans 5:8). The Christian’s eternal destiny is dependent upon the love he possesses and manifests towards others (1 John 3:11 + 14-15).
4. **...THROUGH HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS (3:4-10).** Sin is inevitable in the life of a Christian (1 John 1:8-10). However, the Christian is admonished not to “practice” or live a life of sin (1 John 1:5-6; 3:4, 6, 8-10). Rather, the Christian is to pursue and live a life of righteousness (1 John 3:5, 10). The pattern for a righteous lifestyle is laid out in the pages of inspiration (Romans 1:16-17).

QUESTION: AS CHRISTIANS, CAN WE CONFIDENTLY SAY THAT WE ARE “ABIDING” IN CHRIST?
