**CLEAVE TO THE LORD**

**September 8, 2010**

“When he came and had seen the grace of God, he was glad, and exhorted them all that with purpose of heart, they would **cleave** unto the Lord.” (Acts 11:23).

The Greek word that is translated “cleave” is (kollao). Its definition is “to join fast together, to glue, or cement...”

This definition provides some rather interesting insight into the instruction Barnabas gave the disciples at Antioch.

In Acts 11, the church at Jerusalem, upon hearing of the conversion of the men and women at Antioch, determined to send Barnabas to Antioch to encourage them. When Barnabas arrived in Antioch, he was glad to see their faith in God, and encourage them to **“cleave”** to the Lord.

But now, here is the point I do not want you to miss: These men and women were already disciples. They had already believed and turned to the Lord. Yet, they needed to be encouraged to **“cleave”** (i.e. be glued to) to the Lord.

Does this not imply that there can be difference in one who has obeyed the gospel and one who is following closely to the Lord? I'm afraid there are many people today who have been baptized, professing their faith in Christ, and have become Christians, but who after this act of obedience put forth little effort to follow closely to their Savior.

Have you ever been to the mall at Christmas time with a small child? If so, you fully understand the difference between “following” someone and “cleaving” to someone. Let your child walk on his or her own, without holding your hand, and see what shortly happens. Something will catch his or her eye and before you know it, your child will be separated from you. On the other hand, if you hold your child's hand, no matter how busy the crowd, no matter how many storefront windows and toy stores you pass, you won't become separated from your child. It's the difference between “following” and “cleaving.”

Too often, people will obey the gospel initially. They will begin their walk with God, but because they are not “cleaving” to Him, they become separated. They allow people and things to come between them and God. Following Christ from a distance is wrought with dangers (Matthew 26:58). And before one realized it, he can become lost.

Friends, it's wonderful to hear of one who is a follower of Christ, but let me encourage you to be more than that. Let me encourage you to **“cleave”** (i.e. be glued to) to the Lord.

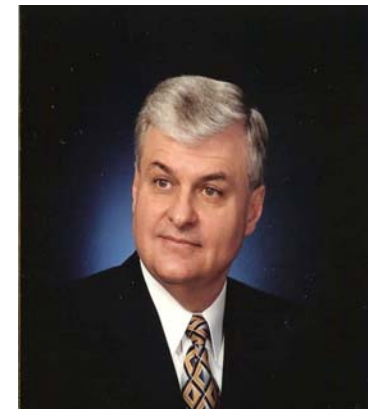
