Don't Be Confused About the Marriage Amendment

Kentucky is one of several states that will vote on marriage amendments on November 2, 2004. Others are Arkansas, Georgia, Michigan, Mississippi, Montana, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, and Utah. The main issue driving these amendments is "gay marriage."

Since the controversial ruling by the Massachusetts Supreme Court allowed gay marriages in that state, many Americans have made moves to stop them from becoming accepted in all states. With our democratic form of government, there should be the right of the people to decide such an issue for themselves. Earlier this summer, an attempt was made to pass a Federal Marriage Amendment. That, however, was unsuccessful.

With the vote on the marriage amendment looming in just a couple of months, it is vital that you understand the language of the amendment and the ramifications of it.

Please realize that you will vote to affirm a positive proposition that will carry a negative result. In other words, though we talk about a ban (negative) on "gay marriages," we must vote "Yes" to do it. This amendment will then effectively define marriage to be between a man and a woman and thus forbid all other similar unions. Please be sure that all those in your household who vote understand this.
