“PLAYING CHURCH”

When I was a child I enjoyed playing church. A group of kids would get together and one would play song leader, one would play preacher, and another would play communion server. “Communion” was made up of crackers and a glass of water as we “played church.” As children, we were not being sacrilegious; we were just children at play and no harm was done. While, “playing church” may be cute in children, it's pretty unbecoming for adults – “when I was a child, I spoke as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child; but when I became a man, I put away childish things” (1Cor. 13:11). However, there may be adults who are still “playing church.” We may “go to church” and say, “You play song leader, you play preacher” and so on. We may come without expectation, without preparation and without excitement and then we leave unchallenged, unchanged and unimpressed.

We do not anticipate much and we get what we expect. Are any who is reading these words just “playing church?” If we are, it is time to reevaluate. When we come to the place of worship let us realize that worship is to approach the sublime—we are in the presence of the holy. Let us realize that worship is to inspire reverence and awe, thanksgiving and praise, and transformation and maturity. Let us remember that in worship we are not the audience, but participate, and God is the “audience.” In worship we are seeking to please God, not ourselves. When we worship we are praising God, remembering Jesus Christ, and edifying each other. As these goals for worship are fulfilled we discover the true meaning of worship and we rise above “playing church” as we worship “in spirit and in truth” (John 4:24).
