**AMERICA MUST WAKE UP NOW**

Dr. Carl Zimmerman was a sociologist who published a book entitled *Family and Civilization* in 1947. He lists eight specific patterns of domestic behavior that signals the downward spiral and imminent demise of every culture.

- 1) Marriage lost its sacredness; it was frequently broken by divorce.
- 2) Traditional meaning of the marriage ceremony was lost. Alternate forms and definition of marriage arose, and traditional marriage vows were replaced by individual marriage contracts.
- 3) Feminists movements appeared, and women lost interest in child bearing and mothering, preferring to pursue power and influence.
- 4) Public disrespect for parents and authority in general increased.
- 5) Juvenile delinquency, promiscuity and rebellion accelerated.
- 6) People with traditional marriages refused to accept family responsibilities.
- 7) Desire for an acceptance of adultery grew.
- 8) Increased tolerance for sexual perversion of all kinds, particularly homosexuality with a resultant increase in sex related crimes.
