- **Youth Care Workers (Part and Full time.)** Successful applicants must possess a bachelor's degree in a human service field, or an associate's degree in a human service field with documented experience in child care. In addition, applicants must pass a criminal background check, possess strong communication skills and be willing to work days, evenings, overnights and/or weekends in a strong faith based agency with abused and neglected teenagers in sometimes difficult and stressful situations.
- **Mental Health Counselor – full time.** Counselor to work with abused and neglected teenage girls in a faith based agency. Applicant must be able to successfully work in a strong Christian environment. Position requires skills in individual and group counseling, an ability and willingness to teach parenting classes and independent living curriculum and be available to work some evenings. QUESTIONS ANSWERED

Please explain Isaiah 28:20: *“For the bed is shorter than that a man can stretch himself on it; and the covering narrower than that he can wrap himself in it.”* The connection of the verse shows that it is only a strong expression, showing that those that go their own ways and will not follow the word of the Lord will have no place to shield them from the judgments of the Lord when they come. Like the bed, their ways and their strength will be too short and too narrow to protect them from the anger of the Lord when he shall take vengeance upon the wicked. The Jewish people at the time of this utterance were very wicked, and the Lord through Isaiah was letting them know that all their defenses and their wisdom would be insufficient to protect them from the ruin that he would bring upon them.
