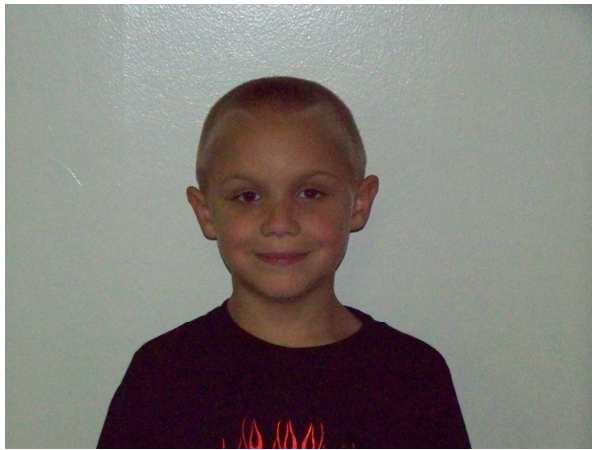

THE CHRISTIAN LIFE

Once while Fritz Kreisler, the great violinist, had several hours to spend between trains, he went to a music store. He laid his violin case, which had his name on it, on the counter. The storekeeper, seeing the name, thought that the musician's violin had been stolen, and called the police. Upon their arrival they went about to arrest Kreisler, thinking he was a thief. All the time, Kreisler was insisting that he was no thief, but that he was the real Kreisler. Finally, he asked the storekeeper if he had one of Kreisler's recordings. He did have, and the record was played. Upon completion of the record, Kreisler opened the case, removed the instrument and played the same piece. Hearing such, the storekeeper and the policeman knew that this was the real Kreisler. You see, his performance proved his profession!

In application, we profess to be Christians, but do we prove it by our performance?

It is not what we eat that makes us strong, but what we digest. It is not what we earn that makes us rich, but what we save. It is not what we read, but what we remember that makes us wise. And, it is not what we say, but what we live that makes us Christians. Yet, often times our Christianity is exhausted in mere profession.

Christian living is that state of being in Christ and Christ being in us. We enter Christ by being baptized into Him (Gal 3:27). We then are to walk in Him, being rooted and built up in Him (Col. 2:6). Also, Christ abides in us. “I am crucified with Christ; nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me”. (Gal. 2:20)

Christian living is also living like Christ – living so others may see Christ in us. We are to have the mind of Christ (Phil. 2:5). We are to follow his example (1 Pet. 2:21). By so doing we will be changed into His image from glory to glory (2 Cor. 3:18). Truly, then, will others be able to see Christ in us. Such is Christian living.
