**“IT GETS LATE EARLY OUT THERE”**

When Daylight Savings Time ended recently & went back to “Standard Time,” it sure seemed like it was getting late a lot earlier. I was reminded of the quote above attributed to Lawrence Peter Berra. Most people know him much better as Yogi Berra. Over the years, he may have become better known for some of his more memorable quotes than for his outstanding major league baseball career. Even if you're not a baseball fan, you've probably seen him in the barber shop in an AFLAC commercial. While most of his quotes at first sound nonsensical & while he claims “*I never said most of the things I said,*” there seems to be a ring of truth to most of his statements. After all, “*it ain't over 'til it's over,*” is it? It is definitely true that “*you can observe a lot just by watching.*” Haven't we all been in situations where “*it was impossible to get a conversation going; everybody was talking too much.*”?

That same sort of kernel of truth seems to be contained in the quote: “*It gets late early out there.*” While he was actually commenting on the difficulty involved in catching a fly ball in the late afternoon shadows in the left field area of Yankee Stadium (especially as summer was turning into fall), the same thing can be said about life itself.

As we go through life, there are, in fact, occasions when it seems like it does get late very early. It seems that those occasions occur with increasing frequency as we age. Those milestones that seemed to be a long distance away when we were young seem to be almost a blur with each passing year. All of a sudden we realize that, even if we are blessed with exceptional health, we have many more years behind us than we have ahead of us.

Maybe that's why the Holy Spirit reminds us of such things as the brevity of life (cf. James 4:14); the importance of making a commitment to God in our youth before the aging process really takes its toll (cf. Eccl. 12:1-8); & the urgency of making a decision about our salvation *now* (cf. 2 Cor. 6:2).

Please do not let it get too late too early for you!
