**OFFICE CLOSED**

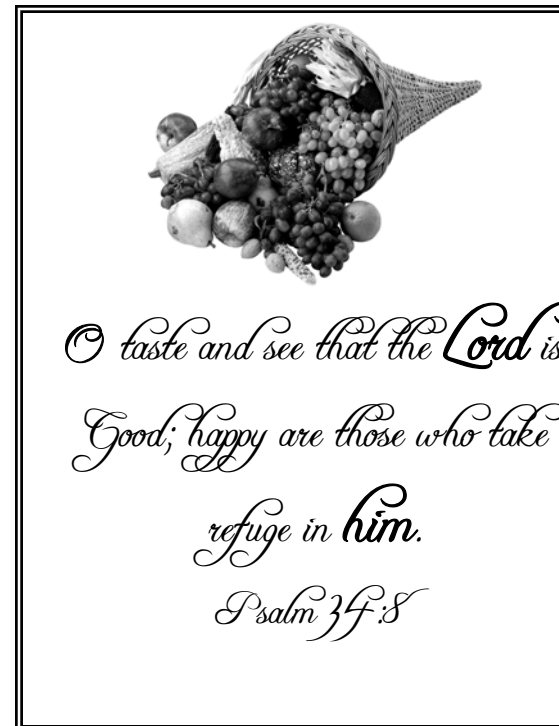
The office will be closed on Thursday and Friday in observance of Thanksgiving.
