**A Fifty-Year Old Decision**

People do not accidentally attend worship without missing one worship service for twenty years. They must have planned to always attend. Soon after I obeyed the gospel in the fall of 1909, I read of an old brother who had not missed going to church a single Sunday in 41 years. That story caused me to resolve and to purpose in my heart that I would never miss the worship on a single Lord’s Day as long as I lived, if possible to attend. I have missed four Sundays in over fifty years, and then it was because of illness. Once I made that decision, the question has not come up as to whether I would attend church service. In fact, I did not decide last Lord’s Day to go to services, nor the Sunday before. That was decided over fifty years ago.

**IT IS A SIN** for any member of the church to miss the worship unless he is unable to attend. The very nature of our religion is such that those who feel this is a burden need to be converted.
