Even In Mayberry

This morning I was reading headline news from across the nation and one headline in particular grabbed my attention. It read, “Man Charged With Killing 4 In Mayberry Model Town”.

On Sunday, November 1, 2009 four men were murdered in the small town of Mt. Airy, North Carolina. For those of you who are not fans of the Andy Griffith Show, you may not know that Mt. Airy is the hometown of Andy Griffith and served as the model and inspiration for the fictional town of Mayberry on “The Andy Griffith Show”.

Police have not released the reasons for the murder, but they did say that they did not believe the killings to be random. Mt. Airy is a small town and has a population of around 8,700. This violent act has turned this little community on its head.
