Music of the Church

In the early churches in America, a presenter was used to direct psalmody. We would probably compare that with what is often referred to as a song leader today.

1. The message of the hymn is designed to draw a person into deep inner thought in an experience of personal communication between himself and God. Human directorship can become a distraction, and the leader of the service must be careful not to do anything that will draw attention from this act of fellowship with God. The presence of a song leader will often contribute to a feeling of unity, and thus make the singing experience more meaningful.

2. The nature of the music. Because of their music structure, some gospel songs require leadership. This is especially true of those with rhythm and tempo changes.

3. A song leader is essential in gatherings where the foremost emphasis is placed on informal fellowship in song. He must thus announce the hymns and some times emphasize briefly their relationship to the service or direct the congregation to the message they contain.
