### "Neither Is There Salvation In Any Other..."

You hear their bells ringing every holiday season. They stand in front of stores with a collection pot hung from a tripod for people to drop in their money. They call themselves the Salvation Army. I had not given them much thought as of late until I received an email that made reference to the Salvation Army. As I said, we see them every holiday season. However, what many do not know is that the Salvation Army is a religious denomination.

Consider a few points from their own website (<http://www.salvationarmy.com>)

1. The **Salvation Army was founded by a former Methodist minister, William Booth, in 1878 in London, England.** The Bible teaches that the Lord Jesus Christ built His church on Pentecost in 33 AD in Jerusalem (Daniel 2; Isaiah 2; Acts 2).

2. **The Salvation Army believes that our first parents were created in a state of innocence...that in consequence of their fall, all men have become sinners, totally depraved, and as such are justly exposed to the wrath of God.** The Bible teaches that sin is something we do (1 John 3:4) not inherit. That man is responsible for his own sin, not the sin of others (Ezek. 18:20; 2 Cor. 5:10).

3. **The Salvation Army believes that repentance toward God, faith in our Lord Jesus Christ and regeneration by the Holy Spirit are all that are necessary to salvation.** The Bible teaches absolute necessity of baptism for salvation (Mk. 16:16; 1 Pet. 3:21).

**Space prevents further examination; however it is clear that to support the Salvation Army is to support a man-made denomination.** "And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove
